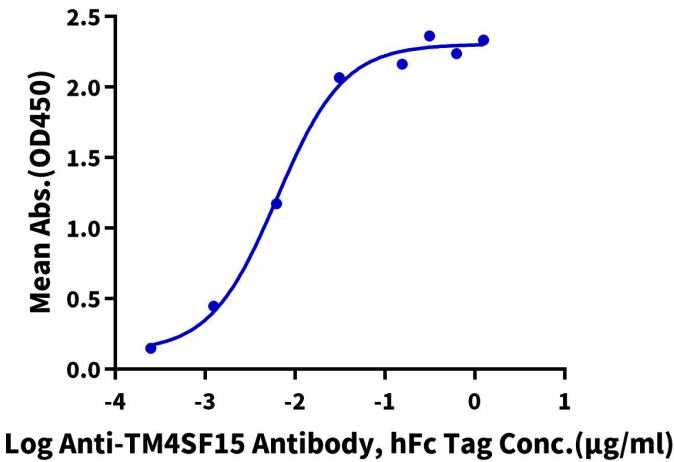
Background	
Tetraspanin 15 (Tspan15) is identified as an ADAM10-interacting protein to induce selective N-cadherin cleavage. Tspan15 belongs to a family of six tetraspanins (Tspan5, Tspan10, Tspan14, Tspan15, Tspan17, and Tspan33) that have been identified as specific ADAM10-interacting protein partners.
